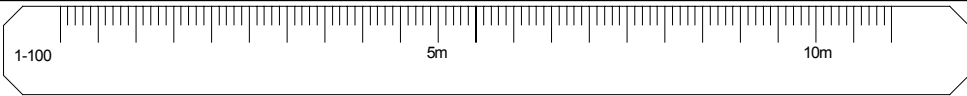


Proposed Ground Floor Plan - 2018-05-16 - v2



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Terms of Planned Service

RELATING TO THE DRAWING

1. All drawings, plans and services supplied by JustPlans are subject to approval under the Town and Country Planning Act.
2. All drawings and information supplied are designed for exclusive use as part of a specific planning application.
3. No drawing or information supplied is designed for any purpose other than as part of a planning application, especially and including any building works or any building regulations requirements.
4. No drawing or information supplied should be used as an on-site reference.
5. No drawing supplied should be scaled from, except by a council officer or administrator for the purpose of either verifying or granting permission for the planning application.
6. No drawing supplied should be used other than the basis of it to corroborate any drawings, observations or works of any kind by a third party. Especially they should not be used as the basis of it to corroborate any future building regulations application.
7. No drawing supplied should be used for a building contractor to build from.
8. Any discrepancy between information contained within the drawing and the actuality on the site must be immediately reported to JustPlans upon discovery.
9. JustPlans's liability for any discrepancy between drawing information and site reality is limited to the duration of the planning process and expires once the council has made decision.
10. In the event that a council awards planning approval but subsequently reflects approval on the basis that drawings or information supplied are inaccurate or incorrect, JustPlans does not accept liability for:
  - (a) any direct or indirect resultant expense
  - (b) providing any additional planning application or amendment to correct the position.
11. Any discrepancy contained within any drawing supplied, we guarantee only to a standard suitable for obtaining planning permission, regulation and registration. Especially they should not be built from.
12. Drawings are approximate only and should not be relied upon for any construction work. Especially they should not be relied upon for any calculations relating to beam size.

RELATING TO THE TERMS OF SERVICE

1. The design (CAD file) remains the exclusive property of Just Plans Ltd.
2. Any changes or amendments required to the draft extension design must be clearly drawn and / or marked on the draft drawings and returned to JustPlans Ltd in either hard or soft copy form.
3. JustPlans commits itself to providing one opportunity for amendments to the draft design as described in paragraph 2 above. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, JustPlans Ltd does not agree to provide additional opportunities to further amend the design.
4. In the event that more than one change to the draft design is nevertheless provided by us, beyond the terms of paragraph 3 above, be advised that such additional modifications greatly increase the likelihood of error being introduced and that all any other critical details, such as drawings, floor levels, etc. might be small or work with an digital copies may become corrupt in such circumstances. JustPlans Ltd takes no responsibility for any resultant problems, whether relating to our own digital files or those of other third parties including the local council.
5. Although our drawings are normally produced using CAD, we offer no guarantee that digital copies of drawings will be kept on file.
6. Any digital copies of drawings which JustPlans Ltd agrees to supply are subject to these terms.
7. When a planning application is received by the local authority it is checked for validity by the planning administration team. JustPlans Ltd gives no guarantee that any application made on your behalf will receive immediate validation and indeed it is common for the validation process to take a considerable period of time.
8. JustPlans Ltd offers no commitment to provide any service for listing and is in no way responsible with any professional person or body for any part of the construction process, including any building contracts, structural engineer or council officer.
9. No guarantee is provided that any drawing supplied will be granted planning approval. Planning permission guidelines are general in nature, vary significantly between councils and are a blend of council rules. Most councils award or deny planning approval based in part on a subjective assessment of the merits of the individual property in relation to the immediate environment. Because of the broad discretionary power it is impossible to predict with certainty or even high accuracy whether a proposal will receive or be denied planning permission.
